The International Palliative Care Family Carer Research Collaboration

Background

The World Health Organization recommends that family carers of people requiring palliative care should be offered optimal support from health and social care professionals. However, there is a shortage of evidence-based strategies to support family carers. Also, there are only a small number of researchers who are focusing specifically on family carer research in palliative care and limited research funding opportunities.

The inaugural meeting of the International Palliative Care Family Carer Research Collaboration (IPCFRC) occurred at the European Association for Palliative Care Research Congress, held in Italy in 2006.



Collaborators and governance

The IPCFRC operates under the auspices of the European Association for Palliative Care. The IPCFRC administrative office is based at the Centre for Palliative Care (c/- St Vincent's Hospital and Collaborative Centre of The University of Melbourne), Australia.
